### Worth a Look

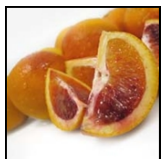


Beautiful **strawberries** are flowing again from premium shippers. Prices are reasonable.

**Stem strawberries** are in ample supply but if you need more than a few, notice is helpful.



Spanish **clementines** are perfectly sweet and delicious.



**Blood oranges'** color is richer and deeper than the first of the season. **Cara Cara oranges** also offer an unexpected punch of color.



**Brussels sprouts** are very reasonably priced and an excellent choice this week.



**Asparagus** prices are noticeably lower and supplies plentiful.



**Broccoli** is back in volume and a tried and true staple.



**Red peppers** are much more readily available and prices are slipping.



**Green pepper** prices are down considerably and shippers are looking to move product with great prices.

There is plenty of **red and green cabbage** to go around. It is being sourced from Florida and Canada.



We now carry pint size, pasteurized **apple cider**. Processed locally in Frederick, Maryland, this cider is packaged in glass and has a nice shelf life.



We also have lots of locally grown **peanuts** from Belmont in Virginia. In addition to regular salted peanuts, we also have **barbeque and chocolate covered peanuts** to add to the list. Just ask your sales rep for details.

### Keep in Mind:

Locally grown **butternut squash** will soon be finished for the season, as most product is now coming from points south.



**Crate basil and arugula** supplies are ample again.



**Eggplant** markets have remained stable throughout the fluctuating weather with product coming from more than one area.



There has been a slight increase in **bananas**.



### Watch

**Honeydew melons** are extremely difficult to source. Some shippers refrained from planting in South America this season because they lost so much last year. Gaps in availability are expected to last another month.



Additional demand has shifted to **cantaloupe melons** where demand now also **exceeds supply**.

Our buyers have been able to cover the demand for **corn** only because demand is low. Growers lost extensive acreage in Florida from recent, prolonged freezing temperatures.



**Blackberry** prices are up only slightly. **Raspberries** supplies are uninterrupted and prices relatively unchanged.



Smaller size **lemons** are higher priced than larger ones. **Oranges** are steadily flowing from California and Florida.



**Yellow foot chanterelle mushrooms** are in stock and **black trumpets** are available with short notice.



**Yellow squash and zucchini** prices are falling but still higher than normal, with supplies slow to recover from the freeze.



**Celery** prices are up drastically.



**Green leaf and romaine** are the most active of lettuce markets. They are also working through issues from very cold temperatures.



Demand for **green onions** exceed supply.
